Dear Prospective Student,

Thank you for your interest in the Spiritual Psychology Course offered at The Chaplaincy Institute (ChI). These two intensives are designed to give you a multi-perspective, holistic model of the human psyche so that you develop practical, emotional and spiritual skills when working with others.

We will be considering how to integrate the body, heart, mind, will and spirit in the healing process. And we will also be looking at dysfunctional patterns that arise in our life experiences and how this impacts our relationship to self, others and the world.

Because of this deep exploration of inner development, as participants move through the material, they will also be going through their own emotional and spiritual process. Participants will be invited to share ("invited" does not mean "have to") personal experiences from the past that may feel risky/fearful to share. It is not uncommon to feel, "stirred up," or overwhelmed. Participants tend to feel all kinds of emotions – some of which are deeply uncomfortable – and others which will likely open the door to some further processing and healing for yourself.

The teachings of this course emphasize the importance for each of, as the Healers, to receive as much healing, active listening and compassionate care as possible. The work we continue to do to heal our own wounds and trauma is the best gift we can offer others. Furthermore, when we have experienced inner healing and come to a deeper understanding of our wounds, dysfunctional patterns and trauma, we can offer a beautiful quality of presence and compassion to others.

The goals and outcomes from this work are intended to help all of us bring our most gifted, mature, open, compassionate self to our role(s) as Healer, Counselor, Spiritual Director, Therapist, Minister, Helper and Companion.
